ATT National Picks 2012

ATT National picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods – Woods has won twice already this year, he won here in 2009 and he's Tiger Woods.

Jim Furyk — Furyk has 2 top 10s in his last 3 events, including a 4th at the US Open and he's 3 top 10s at this event.

Hunter Mahan — Mahan is on a bit of trend and he's 2 top 10s at the ATT National tourney.

Nick Watney — Watney is on a trend as well and he won the ATT National last year, although it was at a different course. Still, if he has got his game together, he can contend.

Adam Scott – Scott is another on a trend and was 15th at the US Open this year.

Robert Allenby — Allenby missed the cut at his last start, however, Allenby has 3 top 10s at this event (2 at Congressional).

Lucas Glover — Glover seems to step it up a bit at the tougher tracks, he's on a slight trend.

Ryan Palmer – Palmer has 4 top 10s in his last 5 starts.

Dustin Johnson — Johnson missed the cut at the US Open, but won the week prior. At a bit easier track than the US Open he can just overpower a course.

Cameron Tringale — Tringale is on a 3 start trend and finished 25th at the event last year. If he's getting hot, he could get his 1st win on tour.
