

Humana/Clinton Picks 2012

The Humana/Clinton Foundation picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site.

Bill Haas — Haas has played well at this event over the past couple of years with a win and a second place finish. And he's posted a couple of top 20s in his last 2 most recent events played.

Martin Laird — Laird has back-to-back top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 starts. And he finished 22 last year at this event.

Matt Kuchar — Kuchar has a couple of top 10s at this event and a top 10 at his most recent start.

Brian Gay — Gay has improved his finishes in each of his last 5 starts at this event and he has a top 10 in his most recent finish. He's on a trend for both the event and his finishes coming into the event.

Kevin Na — A year ago we wouldn't have picked Na to win anything. But, since he won late last year and has a couple of top 10s at this event, he may just get another win.

Greg Chalmers — Years ago it seemed Chalmers was on the verge of becoming a household name in golf. Perhaps he's edging back toward that type of status with back to back overseas wins in recent starts and he's trending in his finishes at this event.

Chris Kirk — Kirk finished 7th last year at this event and has a couple decent finishes recently.

Bo Van Pelt — Van Pelt has finished 11th or better in each of his last 3 starts, including a win overseas, and he finished 5th at this event in '09.

Charles Howell III — Howell is on a 2-way trend, improving in his last 2 starts and improving on each of his finishes at this event.

Anthony Kim — Kim had a couple of top 5 finishes to end last year in a few Asian events. If his top 5s are indicative of a return to form for him, then he could win at anytime.
