Colonial picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 2nd place finishes in 2 of his last 3 events played, he's relatively hot right now and he's 3 top 10 finishes in a row at the Colonial, including a win in '10.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar cooled off a bit with a 15th place finish at the Nelson last week. His record at the Colonial is mixed with one top 10 in the last 5 years played. He is the 5th ranked player in the world though so he comes to the event as one of the favorites.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has back to back to back top 10s with a win and a second place finish in his last 3 events played. His first time at Colonial he finished 16th, he could easily get his second win of the season this week.

Jason Dufner - Dufner back to back? Maybe.

David Toms – Toms won here last year and is on a trend of bettering his finishes over the last 3 weeks played.

Bo Van Pelt – Van Pelt posted a 3rd place finish last year at the Colonial and a 10th place finish in '10. He withdrew from Wells Fargo, but finished 7th at the Players, this could be his week.

Bill Haas – Haas is on a good 2 event trend (missed cut followed by 25th place finish). He's played this event better in each of his last 2 trips here as well.

Harris English — At first glance English seems a bit of a stretch based on recent performance and not having played at this event. However, at an Open Championship qualifier on Monday he shot 60-63, that type of play could easily carry over into the Colonial.

Sean O'Hair — O'Hair has mixed finishes at Colonial and his last finish was a missed cut. He could bounce back with a strong finish this week.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia finished 5th last week in match play in Europe, if he's playing well he could win at Colonial, he has before.
