Greenbrier Picks 2012

Greenbrier picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods — The only question is will Woods' focus be more on prepping for the Open Championship or winning this tournament.

Phil Mickelson — Mickelson can win anytime he tees it up, so if he's playing he should always be considered a pick.

Jim Furyk — Furyk finished 9th at this event in 2010 and is coming off a 34th place finish at ATT National. Furyk rarely has back-to-back finishes outside the top 20..

Webb Simpson – Simpson followed up his US Open win with a 29th finish and took last week off. He finished 9th at Greenbrier last year.

Steve Stricker – Stricker is on a trend of better finishes in his last 2 starts.

Dustin Johnson — Johnson is also on a trend, plus he can most likely overpower this course.

Brendon de Jonge — de Jonge finished in the top 5 last year and the year prior at the Greenbrier, he's also a top 10 and top 15 in his last 2 starts coming into this event.

Jonathan Byrd — Byrd has top 10 finishes in 3 of his last 5 starts and he finished 21st at the Greenbrier in 2010.

Seung-Yul Noh — Noh has top 10 finishes in 2 of his last 3 starts, he hasn't played at Greenbrier in either of last 2 years, but he could still contend.

Cameron Tringale — Tringale ended his trend last week with a 44th place finish. However, he finished 4th at the Greenbrier last year so perhaps he could rebound and contend.
