Pebble Beach Picks 2012

The Pebble Beach picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site.

Tiger Woods — If he's playing, he's a favorite.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson has won here and posted top 10 finishes the last 2 years here. Plus he's on a trend of late, missed cut, followed by 26th finish his last event played.

Jim Furyk – Furyk hasn't finished inside of 30th over his last 3 years played at this event. However, he posted a top 10 in his most recent event played and he can rack those up in bunches.

Dustin Johnson — Johnson won here in back to back years in '09 and '10. The course(s) obviously suit his eye — and game.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan's best finish at this event was last year, he finished 2nd. He missed the cut last week at the Qatar Masters, which is probably good, as he shouldn't be fatigued at this event and could have a strong finish.

Zach Johnson – Johnson hasn't played this event for a number of years, but his most recent finish is 8th place. After a week off, he should be well rested for this even.

Bryce Molder – Molder has back to back top 20 finishes in his last 2 starts and has back to back top 10s at this event.

Rory Sabbatini – Sabbatini is on a trend and had a top 20 finish at Pebble last year.

D.A. Points – Points won here last year, he could repeat.

Spencer Levin – He may not have won last week, but he did get a top 10 and if he's playing well, then he can string along a few good finishes, maybe even a win.
