**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson finished 19<sup>th</sup> last week at the Memorial after 3 months recovering from injury. If he's feeling good physically, then he can contend.

**Zach Johnson** – Johnson has either won or finished runner up in 3 of his last 4 events played.

**Ryan Palmer** – Palmer has 3 top 10s in his last 4 events played.

**Brian Gay** – Gay seems to thrive on TPC courses and this is one and he won here in 2009. Although his recent play isn't exactly stellar, it probably won't matter considering the comfort he has at TPCs.

**Graeme McDowell** – McDowell finished 2<sup>nd</sup> then missed the cut in his last 2 events played, sometimes that 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish or top 10 can push a player to win, especially when followed by a cut. Also, McDowell could be another of those TPC specialists.

**Martin Laird** – Laird is in a position similar to McDowell, missed the cut in his last event, but had a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish the event prior.

**Camilo Villegas** – Villegas is another player who seems to like TPC courses and usually plays them well.

**Heath Slocum** – Slocum is on a bit of a trend and has decent finishes at the St. Jude event.

**Sean O'Hair** – O'Hair was on a bit of a trend prior to his missed cut in his last start.

**Robert Karlsson** – Karlsson finished 2<sup>nd</sup> the last 2 years in a row at St. Jude's.
