Zurich Picks 2012

Zurich picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, etc.

Bubba Watson — Watson is the hottest player on the planet right now. 3 top 5 finishes in a row including the Masters win. And, he won this event last year.

Luke Donald — Donald has dropped off a touch, but he posted a top 10 at Zurich last year, and he won just 3 starts ago at the Transitions.

Steve Stricker – Stricker is similar to Donald in recent finishes without the win, but Stricker does have a win already this year and has posted decent finishes at the Zurich.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley has top 10 finishes in 2 of his last 3 starts and last year he finished 26th in this event – his first time playing at the Zurich.

Nick Watney – Watney is on a bit of a trend and has won this event.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a trend, he has a win this year and he's been consistently in the top 20 in nearly all his starts this year. Rose doesn't have the best record at the Zurich, but his play this year makes up for it.

Jason Dufner – Dufner has posted top 25 finishes in his last 4 starts this year and he's been in the top 10 in each of his last 3 starts at the Zurich.

Jeff Overton — Overton has posted a couple of top 5 finishes in his 4 starts leading into this event. He also has a second place finish at the Zurich, to go along with a 13th place finish. It's Overton's consistency which is questionable.

Cameron Tringale — Tringale has back to back top 10 finishes in his last 2 starts and he's improved his finish position at the Zurich in each of the last 2 years. Tringale should contend this week.

Jerry Kelly – Kelly is on a trend of better finishes over the past 3 events he's played. And, Kelly has won this event.
