Tiger Woods – Woods is the favorite, per usual.

Henrik Stenson — Stenson won last week and finished in the top 3 in 3 of 4 of his most events played.

Adam Scott – Scott finished 53rd last week, but with a week off and 3 of his last 5 events top 5 finishes, including a win, he's still a favorite.

Phil Mickelson — Mickelson has 2 top 10s in his last 5 events played, including a win. The week off should help.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is on a slight trend and won this event in 2010.

Jim Furyk – Furyk has 4 top 10 finishes in his last 5 events played and 3 top 10 finishes at the BMW in 3 of the last 5 years. The week off may help him as well.

Steve Stricker – Stricker has 3 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, including a 2nd place finish last week. Stricker also has 2 top 10 finishes at the BMW.

Justin Rose – Rose won this event in 2011. Rose finished 16th last week and 2nd at the Barclay's the week prior.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a slight trend finishing 4th last week at the Deutsche Bank, he also has 2 top 10 finishes at the BMW over the past 4 years played.

Lee Westwood – Westwood finished 2nd at the BMW last year and he's had a couple back to back top 30's over the past 2 events played.
