Byron Nelson Picks 2013

Byron Nelson picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Marc Leishman – Leishman finished in the top 10 in his last 3 starts in a row. He finished 3rd last year at the Byron Nelson, 12th in 2010 and 8th in 2009.

Jason Day – Day won this event in 2010, he finished 5th in 2011 and 9th last year. Day is also on a slight trend coming into the tourney.

Jason Dufner – Dufner is the defending champion and finished 8th in 2011. But, in 2011 and 2012 he posted much better finishes leading up to this event than he has this year.

Jeff Overton — Overton is on a slight trend and finished in the top 10 in 2 of the last 3 years he's played at the Byron Nelson.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen is the highest ranked player in the field (OWGR), and he's posted top 20 finishes in 3 of his last 4 events played coming into this tourney.

D.A. Points – Points finished in the top 10 in 2 of the last 4 years at the Byron Nelson and he's finished in the top 20 in 2 of his last 3 events played coming into the event.

Robert Garrigus – Garrigus has top 26 finishes in his last 4 Byron Nelson events played.

James Driscoll – Driscoll is on a trend and finished in the top 20 the past 2 years at the Byron Nelson.

Jimmy Walker – Walker is on a slight trend and finished inside the top 30 last year.

Henrik Norlander – Norlander finished in the top 20 in his last 2 events coming into this tourney, however, it is his first time playing in the Byron Nelson.
