Puerto Rico picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Luke Guthrie — Guthrie can flat out play. Guthrie's made 11 starts on the PGATour and missed the cut 3x. On web.com last year Guthrie had 10 starts with 2 wins as part of 7 top 10s.

Jeff Overton – Overton is on a trend and has 3 top 20 finishes at Puerto Rico.

Matt Jones – Jones is also on a trend and finished 5th last year at this event.

Bryce Molder – Molder has a 7th place finish at Puerto Rico in 2010 and he's had 3 straight events played inside the top 25 coming into this tourney.

Brendon de Jonge – de Jonge is on a trend and he's had a 3rd place finish at the event in 2010.

Kevin Stadler – Stadler's finished inside the top 20 at the Puerto Rico in 4 of the last 5 years played. But his last event played was a 58th place finish.

Graham DeLaet – DeLaet is on a trend and finished 9th last year at this event and 24th the year prior.

John Rollins — Rollins is on a trend and he's finished in the top 25 in 4 of his last 5 starts this year.

Michael Bradley — Bradley has won this event 2x in the past years. He's not exactly lighting it up coming into the event with 3 missed cuts and 2 finishes in the 70s, but if anyone could be considered a "horse for a course" it would have to be Bradley.

George McNeill – McNeill is the defending champion and finished 5th at Puerto Rico in 2011.
