## **Shell Picks 2013**

Shell picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Phil Mickelson** — Mickelson won here 2 years ago and finished 4<sup>th</sup> last year, perhaps the course is starting to suit his eye. Mickelson also missed the cut last week but was 3<sup>rd</sup> in his previous start. Plus he generally doesn't miss 2 cuts in a row (except last year...).

**Keegan Bradley** – Bradley finished 3<sup>rd</sup> last week at Bay Hill for his 3<sup>rd</sup> top 10 finish in a row. Bradley also finished 4<sup>th</sup> at the Shell last year.

**Hunter Mahan** – Mahan is the defending champion and he's on a slight trend.

**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson is on a trend, but he's missed the cut at the Shell in 2 starts over the past 5 years (2008 and 2009).

**Steve Stricker** – Tigeresque-like start to the season, less the wins. Stricker has 3 top 10s in 3 starts, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. At the Shell he has 1 top 10 finish in his last 4 starts (4<sup>th</sup> in 2011).

**Lee Westwood** — Westwood has only 1 top 10 finish in his last 5 starts this year and only 1 top 10 finish in the last 4 years (starts) at the Shell. Perhaps we're a bit optimistic from his previous world rankings...

**Louis Oosthuizen** – Oosthuizen has improved his finish at the Shell each time he's played it over the past 5 years. He missed the cut in 2008, was 16<sup>th</sup> in 2011 and 3<sup>rd</sup> last year.

**Henrik Stenson** – Stenson is on a trend and coming off an 8<sup>th</sup> place finish last week. Stenson also finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Shell in 2009 – back when he won the Players and was considered a top player...

**Chris Kirk** – Kirk is on a trend and finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Shell in his only start here in 2011.

**John Senden** – Senden is on a trend and, like Oosthuizen, has improved his finish at the Shell in each of his starts – 31<sup>st</sup> in 2009, 24<sup>th</sup> in 2011 and 18<sup>th</sup> last year.
