Webb Simpson – Simpson has 2 top 10 finishes in his last 3 starts and finished inside the top 15 over the past 3 years at this event, including a 2^{nd} place finish in 2011.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia is on a slight trend and has top 20 finishes in his last 5 events, Garcia also finished 16th last year and 15th the year prior at this tourney.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar finished 35th last week at Doral following the Match play win, but he has a couple good finishes at this tournament over the past few years he's played (10th and 12th).

Jim Furyk — Furyk also finished 35th last week at Doral, but he finished 2nd here last year, 13th in 2011 and he won this event in 2010.

Jason Dufner – Dufner is on a trend and finished 10th here last year.

Luke Donald — Donald is the defending champion and he placed 6th in 2010, he's not off to a great start this year so far, but it's tough to discount the number 3 player in the world and defending champion.

Michael Thompson – Thompson followed his win at the Honda with an 8th place finish at Doral last week. Thompson also finished 16th last year at this tourney, his first start at this event.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen is on a slight trend and he finished 20th last year at this tourney.

Jason Day – Day has 2 top 10 finishes in his last 3 starts. Day's trend at this event is improving each year played over the past 4 year, with a 20th place finish last year.

Brendon de Jonge – de Jonge is on a trend and finished 11th last week at Puerto Rico. Although de Jonge missed the cut last year, he finished 5th in 2011.
