The Masters Picks 2013

The Masters picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods – Woods is the favorite.

Phil Mickelson — Mickelson won here in 2010 and has top 5 finishes in 4 of the last 5 years played (including the win). Plus, he's won here 3 times and has a win already this year.

Bubba Watson — Watson may not be playing as well as he was last year coming into the event, but he is the defending champion and one of the top players and favorites.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley finished 27th last year in his first start at Augusta. Bradley also has 4 top 10s in a row coming into The Masters.

Justin Rose – Rose has 3 top 10 finishes in a row coming into The Masters and finished 8th last year and 11th in 2011.

Adam Scott – Scott finished in the top 10 the last 2 years at Augusta and he has 3 top 15 finishes in his last 5 events played.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is on a bit of a trend with a 3rd place finish in his last event played and he's improved his finish over the past 2 years at The Masters.

Bill Haas — Haas has back to back top 10 finishes coming into The Masters and 3 top 10s in his last 5 events played.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has top 10 finishes in 2 out of his last 3 events played. And he almost won it 2 years ago. And he's the 2nd in the world rankings.

Ian Poulter – Poulter has 2 top 10s over the past 3 years at The Masters.
