The Tour Championship picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods – Woods is the favorite, per usual.

Jim Furyk – Furyk shot 59 last week, nearly won, but finished 3rd. Furyk has 4 straight top 10 finishes at the Tour Championship, missing the 2011 event.

Luke Donald — Donald finished in the top 3 at the Tour Championship for the past 3 years straight. Donald finished 4th at the BMW last week and he's on a trend.

Bill Haas – Haas won this event 2 years ago, and he's on a trend.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan is on a 3 week trend and finished in the top 10 the past 2 years at the Tour Championship.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is another player on a trend and finished 5th last year at this event following a 22nd finish in 2011.

Gary Woodland – Woodland is on a trend and finished 13th at his only Tour Championship appearance in 2011.

Jason Day – Day finished 4th last week, he's on a trend and finished 6th at this event in 2011.

Steve Stricker – Stricker has back to back top 10 finishes coming into the event (and 5 straight top 13 finishes). Stricker's best finish at this event over the last 5 years is 6th in 2009.

Phil Mickelson — Mickelson has 3 top 10 finishes at this event over the last 5 years. He's on a slight trend as well.
