Bubba Watson — Watson may not be as consistent or be playing as well as last year and the end of 2011, but his record here is pretty good - 3 top 10 finishes in the last 5 years, including a win.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan is on a trend, he's won here before and he's had 3 top 15 finishes at the Travelers in the past 5 years.

Jason Dufner – Dufner is on a trend and played a great final round at the US Open, his best this year, it could be the start of a few strong finishes for him. Dufner hasn't played at the Travelers since 2008 when he missed the cut.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is another player on a trend and finished 13th in his last start at the Travelers in 2010.

Lee Westwood — Westwood has 4 top 15 finishes in his last 5 tournaments played coming into the Travelers, including 15 last week at the US Open. It's his first time playing this event.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is trending coming into the Travelers and finished in the top 30 in 3 of the last 5 years at this tourney.

Ryan Moore – Moore has 2 top 10 finishes and a 13th place finish at the Travelers in 3 of the last 4 years played. Moore missed the cut last week, but finished 13th in the event played prior.

Bo Van Pelt – Van Pelt has back to back top 25 finishes coming into the Travelers and 2 top 25 finishes at this tourney in the last 3 times played.

John Rollins — Rollins has back to back top 10s in his last 2 events played and back to back top 10 finishes at the Travelers in the last 2 years.
