Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a trend and finished 13th last year.

Fredrik Jacobson – Jacobson is on a trend and has 3 top 5 finishes at Valero over the last 4 times he's played here.

Cameron Tringale — Tringale is also on a trend and has 2 top 10s in the last 3 times played at Valero.

Brendan Steele – Steele won this event in 2011, finished 4th last year and is on a slight trend.

Charl Schwartzel – Schwartzel has 2 top 10s in his last 3 starts coming into the event.

Peter Hanson – Hanson is on a trend with an 8th place finish in his last start.

Ian Poulter – Poulter is another player on a trend.
