WGC HSBC Champions Picks 2013

WGC HSBC picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson won 2 of his last 4 events played. He also finished 13th at this event in 2010 (the last time he played in it).

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer comes into this event relatively hot, he has back to back 13th place finishes. Kaymer also has 3 top 10s in 4 years at this tourney, including a win in 2011.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson finished 2nd at the WGC HSBC last year, he won it in 2009. Although his most recent finishes aren't great, he could turn it around at any point.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 5 finishes at this event in 3 years played (he didn't play last year). McIlroy has 1 top 10 (a 2nd place) in his last 5 starts.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley is on a trend finishing 16th, 12th and 10th over his last 3 starts. He's finished 16th and 23rd at the WGC HSBC over the past 2 years played.

Ernie Els – Els has 3 top 10 finishes at this event in the last 4 years played. His best finish over his last 5 events is 3rd.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a trend with a 6th place finish in his most recent start. Rose finished 24th at this tourney last year and 7th in 2011.

lan Poulter – Poulter is the defending champion. Poulter is also on a trend, he finished 15th in his last event played. Poulter also has 2 13th place finishes at this tourney.

Francesco Molinari – Molinari won this event in 2010, he's finished in the top 20 in his last 3 events played, including a 2nd place finish in his most recent outing.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth comes into this event with 5 consecutive top 20 finishes, including 2 second place finishes and a 4th place finish. It's his first time playing this tourney.
