**Nick Watney** — Watney is on a trend and finished 5<sup>th</sup> in his last start at the Waste Management tourney in 2011.

**Rickie Fowler** – Fowler has 3 top 10 finishes in a row coming into the event and he finished  $2^{nd}$  at this tourney in 2010.
