Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc. Also, Fedex playoffs not a lot is going to change on this list from event to event...

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy finished in the top 10 in 4 of his 5 most recent events, including 3 wins in a row. McIlroy won the BMW in 2012.

Justin Rose – Rose has 2 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played. Rose skipped last week's event and the rest may help. Rose won the BMW in 2011.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler finished in the top 10 in 4 of the most recent 5 events he's played.

Sergio Garcia — Garcia finished inside the top 10 in 2 of his 4 most recent events played, Garcia also took last week off which could benefit his play this week.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell is on a slight trend, he's 3 top 10s over his 5 most recent events and he took last week off as well.

Jimmy Walker – Walker is on a trend, he finished 9th last week. Walker finished 11th at the BMW last year.

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer is another player on a trend with a 7th place finish last week after missing 2 cuts in a row in his previous 2 events played.

Zach Johnson – Johnson is also on a trend with a 16th place finish last week and he hasn't missed a cut in his 5 most recent events played. Johnson is the defending champion.

Adam Scott – Scott has 5 top 20 finishes in a row in his 5 most recent events played, Scott finished 6th at the BMW in 2012.

Jim Furyk – Furyk has 3 top 10s in his 5 most recent events played and he's 3 top 10s at this event over the past 5 years.
