Rory McIlroy — McIlroy has 3 wins in a row coming into this event. He finished 19th at Barclays last year.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 5 top 10 finishes in a row in his 5 most recent events played. Fowler finished 9th at Barclays last year.

Henrik Stenson — Stenson won the Fedex Cup last year. Stenson has 3 top 10s in his 5 most recent events played.

Adam Scott – Scott had 4 top 10 finishes in a row ended with a 15th place finish at the PGA. Scott is the Barclays defending champion.

Jim Furyk — Furyk has 5 top 15 finishes in a row coming into Barclays, including 3 top 5 finishes. Furyk was 6th last year at this event.

Justin Rose – Rose has 3 top 15 finishes at Barclays over the past 4 years, including 2 top 10s. Rose has 5 top 25 finishes in his 5 most recent events played including 2 wins and a 4th place finish.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has three 2nd place finishes in his 5 most recent events played. Garcia's best finish at Barclays in past 5 years is 3rd in 2012.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson is on a trend and he finished 2nd at the PGA, his most recent event played. Mickelson finished 6th at Barclays last year.

Charl Schwartzel – Schwartzel has 2 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played and he finished 15th at the PGA. Last year Schwartzel finished 25th at Barclays and 24th in 2012.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker is on a trend, he finished 13th at the PGA and 5th last week at Wyndham. Snedeker also finished 2nd at the Barclays in 2012 and 3rd in 2011.
