Bay Hill Picks 2014

Bay Hill picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Bubba Watson — Watson has 4 top 10s in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Watson also has 3 consecutive years of top 25 finishes at Bay Hill over the past 3 years.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a slight trend with an 8th place finish last week at Valspar. Rose finished 2nd at Bay Hill last year and 3rd in 2011. (He finished 15 at Bay Hill in 2012).

Hunter Mahan – Mahan finished in the top 10 in 4 of the last 5 events he's played. Mahan has not missed a cut at Bay Hill in the last 5 years; however, his best finish here is 21st.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson is on a trend coming into Bay Hill and he's improved his finish at Bay Hill in each year since 2010. Stenson finished 8th at this event last year.

Ryan Moore – Moore has finished inside the top 25 in 4 out of 5 of his most recent starts. Moore also finished 4th at Bay Hill in 2012 and 12th in 2011 (he missed the cut last year).

Zach Johnson – Johnson is on a trend and he has 2 top 10s in his 5 most recent starts.

Will MacKenzie — MacKenzie has 3 top 10s in his last 5 most recent events played, including 2 back to back his last 2 starts. However, MacKenzie hasn't played this event since 2009 when he missed the cut.

Adam Scott – Scott has 3 top 10s in his last 5 most recent events played, like MacKenzie he hasn't played Bay Hill since 2009 when he missed the cut, but Scott, unlike MacKenzie, has 4 wins since the start of 2013 and is ranked 2nd in the world by the OWGR.

Patrick Reed — Reed is coming off a win at Doral, his most recent event played. Reed missed the cut at Bay Hill last year, but he's a bit different (better) of a player this time around.

Kevin Na — Na has 2 top 10s in his last 3 most recent events played. Na also has 2 top 5 finishes at Bay Hill in the last 5 years (4th in 2012, 2nd in 2010).
