Colonial picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 5 finishes in a row at the Colonial, including 2 wins.

Jim Furyk — Furyk has 4 top 10 finishes in his last 5 recent events played. Furyk also has 2 top 10 finishes in the last 5 years at this event.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 4 top 10s in his last 5 events played, including a win. Kuchar finished 2nd at Colonial last year.

Paul Casey – Casey has 3 top 20 finishes in a row coming into this tourney, the last 2 times he played Colonial he finished 13th in 2010 and 5th in 2009.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson finished 7th last week at the Byron Nelson, he's on a trend. Johnson is also ranked 3rd on tour in birdie average, 4th in putting average, 6th in GIRs and 1st on the all-around ranking.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 2 top 5 finishes in his last 4 recent events played and he finished 7th last year at the Colonial, his debut at this tourney.

Bo Van Pelt – Van Pelt is on a trend and he has 2 top 10 finishes at this tourney in the last 5 years played, he also hasn't missed a cut at Colonial in that time.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 2 top 10 finishes in his last 5 recent events played. Fowler finished 5th at Colonial in 2012 and 16th in 2011.

Boo Weekley – Weekley is the defending champion at this event, he's on a trend coming into the tourney and he finished 9th in 2010 at the Colonial. He hasn't missed a cut here in the last 4 years straight.

Ryan Palmer – Palmer is on a trend coming into the Colonial, he finished 14th at this tourney last year and 5th in 2012.
