John Deere picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Steve Stricker – Stricker won this event 3 times in a row from 2009 through 2011 and finished 5th and 10th the last 2 years, respectively. Stricker finished inside the top 35 in his 5 most recent events played.

Jordan Spieth — Spieth is the defending champion and he's finished inside the top 20 in his 4 most recent events played.

Zach Johnson – Johnson finished inside the top 3 at this tourney in 4 of the last 5 years, including a win. Johnson has only 1 top 30 finish in his 5 most recent events played.

Harris English – English is on a trend and finished 15th last year at this tourney.

Ryan Moore – Moore is another player on a trend, he's only missed the cut once in his 5 most recent events played and he finished 8th at John Deere in 2012.

Chris Stroud – Stroud finished inside the top 20 in 3 of his most recent 4 events played. Stroud is on a trend, he finished 4th last week and has a 15th at John Deere in 2009.

Scott Langley — Langley has missed only one cut in his most recent 5 events played, he was on a trend prior to last week and he's trending in this event (cut in 2011, 33 in 2013).

Ben Martin — Martin was on a trend prior to missing the cut at Greenbrier. Martin finished 38th at John Deere in 2011, the only time he's played this event.

Kyle Stanley – Stanley is on a trend and he finished 2nd at John Deere in 2011 to go along with a 19th place finish in 2012, although he did miss the cut last year...

Michael Thompson – Thompson is on a trend and finished 12th at this event in 2011, his only start at John Deere in the past 5 years.
