Sony Open picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Adam Scott** – Scott has 5 top 10 finishes in a row coming into this event, including 2 wins. Scott also finished 2<sup>nd</sup> here in 2009.

**Zach Johnson** — Johnson has back to back wins in his last 2 events played. Johnson won this tourney in 2009.

**Matt Kuchar** – Kuchar has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he has 2 5<sup>th</sup> place finishes at the Sony Open, last year and 2011.

**Jordan Spieth** — Spieth has 3 top 10s in his last 5 events played, including a pair of 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes.

**Charles Howell III** – Howell is on a trend and has 3 top 10s in his 5 most recent events played. Howell has finished in the top 5 at this event in 4 of the last 5 years.

**Harris English** – English finished 11<sup>th</sup> last week and won the prior tourney he played. English finished 9<sup>th</sup> at the Sony Open last year.

**Chris Kirk** – Kirk finished 16<sup>th</sup> at the Hyundai last week – coming off a win the prior event he played. Kirk finished 5<sup>th</sup> at the Sony last year.

**Jeff Overton** – Overton is on a trend and finished 8<sup>th</sup> here last year.

**Brian Gay** — Gay is on a trend and has posted 2 top 10 finishes at the Sony over the past 5 years.

**Hideki Matsuyama** — Matsuyama has back to back top 10s coming into this tourney, including a win. Although Matsuyama has yet to make a cut at the Sony, he will likely contend this time around.
