Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc. Also, Fedex playoffs not a lot is going to change on this list from event to event...

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 2 wins and 2 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played. McIlroy finished 10th at this tourney in 2012.

Bubba Watson — Watson is on a trend, he finished 2nd last week and finished 5th at the Tour Championship in 2012.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler finished in the top 10 in 4 of the most recent 5 events he's played.

Jim Furyk – Furyk finished in the top 10 in 3 of his most recent 4 events played. Furyk also has 3 top 10s at the Tour Championship over the past 5 years, including a win in 2010.

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer finished 16th last week at the BMW after finishing 7th the week prior. It's his first Tour Championship.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth is on a trend, he finished 8th last week and 2nd last year at this event.

Billy Horschel – Horschel is on a roll, he finished 2nd the week before last and he won last week. In his first Tour Championship, last year, Horschel finished 7th.

Justin Rose – Rose hasn't missed a cut in his 5 most recent events played with 1 top 10 finish. However, Rose finished 6th at this event last year and 2nd in 2012.

Adam Scott – Scott has 5 top 20 finishes in a row in his 5 most recent events played, Scott finished 6th at the Tour Championship in 2011.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia is on a trend and finished 4th last week. Garcia also finished 9th last year at this tourney and 15th in 2012.
