Travelers picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Bubba Watson — Watson may have missed the cut last week at the US Open, but he's still posted top 5 finishes in 2 of his last 4 starts, including a win (The Masters). Watson finished in the top 4 at this tournament in 3 of the last 4 year.

Brian Davis — Davis has 2 top 10 finishes at the Travelers in the last 3 years. Davis also has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley is on a trend and finished 4th at the US Open last week. Bradley has bettered his finish at the Travelers in each of the last 2 years played.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar finished 8th at the Travelers in 2012, his only start in 5 years at this event. Kuchar has top 20 finishes in 4 of his 5 most recent events played.

Charley Hoffman – Hoffman is on a trend and he's finished inside the top 10 at the Travelers the past 2 years straight, including a 2nd place finish in 2012.

Tommy Gainey — Gainey has 3 straight top 20 finishes at the Travelers and he's on a trend coming into the event.

Ryan Moore – Moore has 3 top 10 finishes at the Travelers over the past 5 years.

Jason Day – Day finished 4th at the US Open last week and is on a trend.

Graham DeLaet – DeLaet has 2 top 15 finishes in his 3 most recent events played. DeLaet also finished 3rd at this event last year.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan has 3 top 25 finishes at the Travelers in the past 5 years. Mahan was on a trend prior to missing the cut at the US Open last week.
