Valspar picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 3 top 10s and a 13th in his last 5 events played, he finished 14th at Valspar last year, 10th in 2012 and 12th in 2009 (he skipped 2010 and 2011).

Webb Simpson — Simpson has 4 consecutive top 20 finishes at Valspar over the past 4 years. Simpson is a little up and down over his last 5 events played, but has 2 top 10s and a top 25.

Harris English – English has 4 consecutive top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, and he finished 7th at this event last year. He seems to be the pick for the week.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth finished 7th last year and he has 2 top 10 finishes in his last 4 events played.

Jim Furyk – Furyk won this event in 2010, he finished 7th last year and 2nd in 2012. Furyk has 2 top 10s over his last 5 events played.

Luke Donald – Donald won here in 2012, he finished 4th last year and 6th in 2010. Donald hasn't missed a cut over his last 5 events played, with one top 10 finish.

Bill Haas – Haas is on a trend, he finished 6th last week at Doral. His best finish at Valspar is 16th in 2010 (over the past 5 years).

Jason Dufner — Dufner comes into this event with back to back top 10 finishes. Dufner has 5 consecutive top 30 finishes at this event with one top 10 in 2012.

Jonas Blixt – Blixt is on a bit of a trend and he finished 38th at this event last year.

Justin Rose – Rose has 2 top 10s in his most recent 5 events played.
