Waste Management picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 4 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, including a win. Simpson also finished 8th in his last 2 starts at this event (2012 and 2011).

Ryan Palmer – Palmer comes into this event with back to back top 10s in his last 2 tourneys played. Palmer finished 5th here last year.

Bubba Watson — Watson is on a slight trend and he's finished inside the top 30 in 4 of the last 5 years at this tourney.

Ryan Moore — Moore is coming off consecutive top 10 in his 2 most recent events and he's finished inside the top 10 at this event in 2 of the last 5 years.

Brendan Steele – Steele is on a trend and he's posted consecutive top 10s at this tourney in the last 2 years.

Marc Leishman – Leishman has 3 consecutive top 10 finishes in his last 3 events played.

Billy Horschel – Horschel is on a slight trend, he hasn't missed a cut in his last 5 most recent events played and he finished 11th at this tourney in his debut here last year.

Brian Stuard — Stuard ended his 3 consecutive top 10 streak last week, finishing 28th. He should bounce back this week.

Gary Woodland – Woodland is on a trend and finished 10th last week. He's finished in the top 20 in 2 of the last 3 years at Phoenix.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley comes into this event with 3 consecutive top 20 finishes, seems he's close for a break through. He finished 24th here last year and 15th in 2012.
