Barclays picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 5 consecutive top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Spieth also finished 22nd at Barclays last year and 19th in 2013.

Jason Day – Day has 5 consecutive top 12 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Day also has 5 straight years of top 25 finishes at the Barclays, including 2nd last year and 5th in 2010.

Justin Rose – Rose has 4 consecutive top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Rose has 2 top 10 finishes at this event (2013 and 2011).

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 5 top 20 finishes in his 5 most recent events played (4 top 10s).

Robert Streb – Streb has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 top 10s).

Matt Kuchar — Kuchar has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Kuchar won this event in 2010 to go along with 2 top 5 finishes in the past 5 years.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is on a trend with a 7th place finish in his most recent event played. Johnson won this event in 2011 (3rd in 2012 and 9th in 2010).

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Fowler also finished 9th last year and in 2013 at Barclays.

Jim Furyk – Furyk has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Furyk has back to back top 10 finishes at Barclays over the past 2 years.

Bubba Watson — Watson finished 2nd in 2 of his most recent 3 events played. Watson finished 10th at Barclays in 2012.
