HSBC picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Adam Scott – Scott has consecutive top 10 finishes over his past 2 events played. Scott also has 3 top 15s at this tourney in the past 4 years.

Bubba Watson — Watson is the defending champion and he has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Dustin Johnson — Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Johnson won the HSBC in 2013.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he's 3 top 10s at HSBC over the past 5 years.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win (and a 2nd). Spieth finished 35th at this event last year.

Kevin Na – Na has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 second's and a third. Na finished 20th at HSBC last year.

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer is on a slight trend and he has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Kaymer has 4 top 10 finishes at HSBC in the past 4 years, including a win in 2011.

Kiradech Aphibarnrat — Aphibarnrat has 4 consecutive top 6 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Emiliano Grillo — Grillo has 3 top 2 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. First time at HSBC.

Matthew Fitzpatrick — Fitzpatrick has 3 top 3 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. First time at HSBC.
