Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.

Harris English – English won this event in 2013 and he hasn't missed a cut in his most recent 5 events played.

Chris Stroud – Stroud has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Stroud also has 3 top 5 finishes at Mayakoba over the last 4 years.

Johnson Wagner – Wagner is on a trend with a 15th place finish in his most recent event played. Wagner won this tourney in 2011 and he finished 16th last year.

Patton Kizzire – Kizzire has 3 consecutive top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played.

Jason Bohn – Bohn has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Bohn also has 2 top 10 finishes in the last 2 years at Mayakoba.

Patrick Rodgers – Rodgers has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rodgers finished 37th at this event last year.

Jason Kokrak – Kokrak is on a trend with a 12th place finish last week to go along with a 16th place finish last year at this tourney.

Brendan Steele – Steele is on a trend and he has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Steele finished 16th at Mayakoba in 2013 and 37th last year.
