Shell Picks 2015

Shell picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 4 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, including a win. Spieth finished 50th at this event in 2013, missed the cut last year.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a trend with a 15th place finish in his most recent event played. Kuchar finished 2nd at Shell last year and 8th in 2010 and 2011 (non participant in 2012 and 2013).

Lee Westwood — Westwood has 5 consecutive top 25 finishes coming into this tourney. Westwood also finished inside the top 25 in the last 3 years at Shell.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia finished 3rd at Shell last year and he has back to back 31st place finishes coming into this event.

Ryan Moore — Moore is on a bit of a trend to go with back to back top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen has 2 top 10 finishes in his 3 most recent (and only) events played in 2015. Oosthuizen finished 10th at Shell in 2013 and he finished 3rd in 2012.

J.B. Holmes — Holmes was on a trend prior to missing the cut in his most recent event played. In the past 3 years, Holmes played this event twice, he finished 12th last year and 8th in 2012.

Patrick Reed – Reed finished 2nd in his most recent event played, lost in playoff at Valspar. Reed has 2 top 10s in his most recent 3 events played.

Jason Kokrak – Kokrak finished 9th at Shell in 2013, he has 2 top 10s in his most recent 3 events played and he finished 11th at Valero last week.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler hasn't missed a cut in his 5 most recent events played... and he finished 6th at this tourney last year.
