The Open Championship picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth — Spieth won his most recent 2 events played. Spieth is the highest ranked player in the field. Spieth won the first 2 majors of this year.

Dustin Johnson — Johnson has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Johnson also has 4 top 15 finishes at The Open in the past 5 years.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is coming off a win at the Scottish Open last week. Fowler also has 2 top 10 finishes in the last 4 Open Championships (2014, 2011).

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker has finished in the top 10 in his most recent 4 events played. Snedeker finished 3rd at The Open in 2012 and 11th in 2013.

Adam Scott – Scott is on a trend. Scott has 3 consecutive top 5 finishes at The Open over the past 3 years.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson is on a trend and he's finished top 3 at The Open twice over the past 5 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Matsuyama also finished 6th at The Open in 2013.

Phil Mickelson — Mickelson is on a trend and he's 2 top 2 finishes at The Open in the past 4 years, including a win in 2013.

Charl Schwartzel — Schwartzel has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Schwartzel has 4 top 16 finishes in the past 5 years at The Open Championship.

Victor Dubuisson – Dubuisson is on a trend and he's 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Dubuisson finished 9th at The Open Championship last year.
