Justin Rose – Rose has 2 top 10 finishes in his last 2 events played. Rose finished 4th at Bridgestone last year and 5th in 2012.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is on a trend with a runner up finish last week at Quicken Loans. Fowler has 2 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

Adam Scott — Scott has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this event and he has 3 top 10 finishes at Bridgestone over the past 5 years, including a win in 2011.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a trend and he has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Kuchar has finished inside the top 27 for 5 years in a row at this tourney.

Jason Day – Day has 3 top 10 finishes in a row over his most recent 3 events played, including a win at the Canadian Open. Day finished 4th at Bridgestone in 2011.

Jim Furyk — Furyk is on a trend with a 4th place finish in his most recent event played. Furyk has 4 top 15 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has back to back 6th place finishes over his most recent 2 events played. Garcia finished 2nd at this event last year.

Zach Johnson — Johnson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win at The Open Championship. Johnson has 2 top 10 finishes at Bridgestone over the past 4 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is on a trend with a top 10 finish in his most recent event played. Matsuyama finished 12th at this tourney last year.
