**Bubba Watson** – Watson is on a trend with 2 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, including a win. Watson finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at Waste Management last year and 5<sup>th</sup> in 2012.

**Jordan Spieth** – Spieth is coming into this event with back to back wins in his 2 most recent events played with a 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish in the event prior to the 2 wins. This is his first start at Waste Management.

**Brendan Steele** – Steele is on a trend with a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish at Humana last week. Steele finished in the top 10 the last 3 years in a row at this event.

**Rickie Fowler** – Fowler has 4 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played. Fowler finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at this tourney in 2010.
