Scottish Open picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Branden Grace – Grace has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Grace finished 17th at this tourney last year and 2nd in 2013.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Stenson finished 3rd at the Scottish Open in 2013 and he finished 8th in 2012.

Chris Wood — Wood is on a trend coming into this event and he has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.

Joost Luiten – Luiten has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Luiten finished 4^{th} at this event last year.

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer is on a trend coming into this tourney and he has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Kaymer finished 29th at the Scottish Open in 2012.

Luke Donald — Donald is on a slight trend coming into this event with a 45th in his most recent event played. Donald finished 7th here in 2015, 16th in 2014 and 2012, 1st in 2011.

Rafael Cabrera-Bello — Cabrera is on a trend coming into this tourney to go along with 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Marc Warren – Warren is on a slight trend coming into the Scottish Open. Warren finished 4th at this tourney last year, 3rd in 2014 and 3rd in 2012.

Raphael Jacquelin — Jacquelin has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. And Jacquelin has 2 top 10 finishes at the Scottish Open over the past 3 years.

Russell Knox – Knox has 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Knox finished 10th at this event last year and he finished 27th in 2014, trending.
