**Dustin Johnson** – Johnson is on a trend coming into this event and he has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Johnson won St. Jude in 2012 and he finished 10<sup>th</sup> in 2013.

**Phil Mickelson** – Mickelson is on a trend coming into St. Jude with a 20<sup>th</sup> finish at Memorial last week. Mickelson has 2 top 10 finishes at St. Jude over the past 3 years.
