Tour Championship picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win at BMW last week. Johnson finished 5th at this event last year and 5th in 2013 as well.

Adam Scott – Scott finished 4th in his 3 most recent events played. Scott finished 9th at this tourney in 2014 and he finished 6th in 2011.

Patrick Reed — Reed has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win at Barclays.

Paul Casey – Casey finished 2nd in his most recent 2 events played. Casey finished 5th at the Tour Championship last year.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth is on a trend coming into this event and he has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Spieth is the defending champion to go along with a 2nd in 2013.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win at Deutsche Bank. McIlroy finished 2nd at this event in 2014.

Jimmy Walker – Walker has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win at the PGA. Walker finished 18th here last year at 17th in 2014.

Ryan Moore – Moore has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Moore finished 3rd at the Tour Championship in 2012.

Matt Kuchar — Kuchar is on a trend coming into this event. Kuchar also has 2 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker is another player on a trend coming into this tournament and he won this event in 2012.

Others to consider, in no particular order:
