Shriners picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Chesson Hadley – Hadley has 4 top 3 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Hadley finished 5th at Shriners in 2013.

Tony Finau – Finau has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Finau is on a trend coming into this event and he finished 7th at Shriners in 2014.

Ryan Moore – Moore is on a trend coming into Shriners and he finished 15th last year here and he won in 2012.

Anirban Lahiri – Lahiri has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, he's on a slight trend coming into this tourney.
