Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win last week at Pebble Beach. Spieth finished 4th at Riviera in 2015.

Bubba Watson — Watson is the defending champion and he won the tourney in 2014 as well. Watson has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Dustin Johnson — Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Johnson has 4 top 5 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Matsuyama finished 4th at Riviera in 2015 and he finished 11th last year.

Justin Thomas — Thomas has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins.

Adam Scott – Scott has 5 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 top 10s). Scott finished 2nd at Riviera last year and he finished 10th in 2013.

Francesco Molinari – Molinari has 5 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Justin Rose – Rose has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Rose finished 16th at Riviera last year and he finished 13th at this event in 2012.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Garcia also finished 4th at Rivera in both 2015 and in 2012.

Brandt Snedeker — Snedeker has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (3 top 10s) and he's on a trend coming into Riviera.
