SBS picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 4 wins in his most recent 5 events played (the other finish was 2nd). Matsuyama finished 3rd in his debut at SBS in 2015.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Spieth is the defending champion and he finished 2nd in 2014.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Johnson also has 3 top 10s at SBS over the past 4 years, including a win in 2013.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Snedeker finished 3rd at this tourney last year and 3rd in 2013.

Jason Day – Although Day has WD's in his most recent 2 events, those were a couple of months ago. Day finished 10th at this event last year and 3rd in 2015.

Bubba Watson — Watson is on a trend coming into SBS along with 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Watson has 3 top 10s at this event over the past 4 years.

Justin Thomas — Thomas has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Thomas is also on a trend coming into this tourney.

Russell Knox – Knox has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Jason Dufner – Dufner is on a trend coming into this event and he finished 5th at SBS in 2014.

Jimmy Walker — Walker is another player on a trend coming into this tourney and he has back to back top 10 finishes at SBS in 2016 and 2015.
