The Masters picks 2017

The Masters picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 straight wins in his most recent 3 events played. Johnson finished 4th at The Masters last year and he finished 6th in 2015.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. McIlroy has 3 consecutive top 10s at Augusta over the past 3 years.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Spieth finished 2nd at The Masters last year, he won in 2015 and he was 2nd in 2014.

Justin Rose — Rose has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Rose has 4 top 15 finishes at Augusta over the past 5 years.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Fowler finished 5th at The Masters in 2014 and he was 12th in 2015.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. This is Rahm's first start at The Masters.

Tyrrell Hatton — Hatton has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. This is Hatton's first Masters start.

Lee Westwood — Westwood has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Westwood has 4 top 10 finishes at Augusta over the past 5 years.

Paul Casey – Casey has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Casey finished 4th at The Masters last year and he finished 6th in 2015.

Jason Day – Day has 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Day has 3 top 20 finishes at Augusta over the past 4 years.
