Justin Thomas – Thomas has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Thomas finished 3rd at this event last year.

Paul Casey – Casey has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Casey finished 17th at Travelers last year and he finished 2nd in 2015.
