Valero picks are based mostly on recent performance with some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Brendan Steele — Steele won this event in 2011. He's had 3 top 15s since and he's on a trend coming into Valero.

Branden Grace — Grace is also on a trend coming into this event and he finished 9th here last year.

Luke Donald — Donald finished 2nd in his most recent event at Harbour Town. Donald finished 13th at Valero last year.

Kevin Chappell – Chappell is on a trend coming into this tourney. Chappell finished 4th last year and he finished 15th at Valero in 2013.

Charley Hoffman – Hoffman has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Hoffman is the defending champion with 4 other top 15 finishes in the past 5 years at Valero.
