

Safeway Open 2018 Picks

Safeway Open picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Snedeker finished 17th at this even in 2015.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he's on a trend coming into Safeway.

Emiliano Grillo – Grillo has 1 top 10 finish in his most recent 2 events played. Grillo won this event in 2015 and he has 2 top 30 finishes over the past 2 years at this tourney.

Adam Hadwin – Hadwin has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 3 events played and he is on a trend coming into this event.

Joaquin Niemann – Niemann is another player on a trend coming into this event to go with 1 top 10 finish in his most recent 5 events played.

Tyler McCumber – McCumber has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 6 events played, including 3 wins. McCumber is also on a trend coming into Safeway.

Lucas Glover – Glover is another player on a trend coming into this event to go with 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Glover finished 30th last year and 17th in 2015.

Brendan Steele – Steele is on a slight trend coming into Safeway. Steele won Safeway both last year and he also won the event in 2016.

Beau Hossler – Hossler is on a slight trend coming into Safeway with 2 top 35 finishes in his most recent 2 events played.

Denny McCarthy – McCarthy has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.
