Shriners picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Tony Finau – Finau has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Finau also has 3 top 20 finishes over the past 4 years at Shriners.

Adam Schenk – Schenk has 5 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, 4 top 10s. Schenk finished 20th at this event last year.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Simpson won this event in 2013.

Gary Woodland – Woodland has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he finished 18th at this tourney last year.

Bryson DeChambeau – DeChambeau has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 wins. DeChambeau finished 7th at Shriners last year.

Patrick Cantlay – Cantlay has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is on a trend coming into Shriners. Cantlay is the defending champion.

Aaron Wise – Wise has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played and he's on a slight trend coming into this tourney. Wise finished 10th here in 2016 and 32nd here last year.
