Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including a win. Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Charley Hoffman – Hoffman has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Hoffman has 3 top 20 finishes at The Canadian Open over the past 5 years (2 top 10s).

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win at the U.S. Open. Koepka finished 18th at this tourney in 2015.

Tony Finau – Finau has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Finau finished 5th at this event last year and he finished 22nd here in 2015.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a trend coming into The Canadian Open with a 9th place finish last week at The Open Championship. Kuchar has 4 top 10 finishes at The Canadian Open over the past 5 years.

Joaquin Niemann – Niemann has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Harold Varner III – Varner has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Varner finished 23 at this event last year.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner is on a trend coming into this event with a 2nd place finish at The Open last week. Kisner finished 9th at this tourney in 2014.

Stewart Cink – Cink has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 top 5 finishes. Cink finished 5th at this event in 2015.

Jhonattan Vegas – Vegas has won The Canadian Open the past 2 years.
