Colonial picks are based on recent performance and some historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the website. Others to consider are based on factors such as stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth is on a trend coming into Colonial with a 3rd finish at the PGA last week. Spieth has a win and 2 runner up finishes at this tourney over the past 4 years.

Jon Rahm – Rahm has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played (2 top 10s). Rahm finished 5th at Colonial last year and 2nd in 2017.

Justin Rose – Rose has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rose is the defending champion.

Paul Casey – Casey has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Casey finished 10th at Colonial in 2017.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Kisner won this event in 2017, he finished 10th in 2016 and he was 5th in 2015.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Oosthuizen finished 5th at this tourney last year.

Emiliano Grillo – Grillo is on a trend coming into this event with a 23rd finish last week. Grillo finished 3rd at Colonial last year and he was 24th in 2017.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Fowler finished 14th at this tourney last year.

Rory Sabbatini –Sabbatini has 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played (2 top 10s). Sabbatini finished 20th at Colonial last year and he finished 10th in 2015.

Danny Lee – Lee is on a trend coming into this tourney to go along with 4 straight years of top 25 finishes at Colonial (2 top 10s).
