Billy Horschel – Horschel has 3 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 top 10s. Horschel finished 21st at this tourney last year.

Danny Lee – Lee has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Lee finished 2^{nd} last year and he finished 3^{rd} at Mayakoba in 2014.

Harris English – English has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Lanto Griffin – Griffin has 5 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.
