**Jason Day** – Day has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Day has 3 top 5 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins.

**Patrick Cantlay** – Cantlay has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Cantlay finished 35<sup>th</sup> last year at this tourney.
